### POINTS TO PONDER FOR SEPTEMBER

Are you a 3<sup>rd</sup> semester student? Have you finished your Div 1 requirements? No? Be sure to complete requirements this semester. If you have completed all requirements for Div 1, talk to your advisor to find out what they want included in the Div 1 portfolio. Start working on it and schedule a final meeting. This fall you will be required to participate in the Div 2 committee request process and will be assigned a Div 2 committee by mid October. Div 2 contracts will be signed in early February.

Are you a 4<sup>th</sup> semester student? You **really** care about the September 17<sup>th</sup> Div 2 filing deadline. Make sure your committee ‘signs’ your contract.

Mid-Semester Evals: All Fall 2020 and Spring 2020 entrants get them. Start by doing a mid-semester self-evaluation due September 23.

<u>Why do I care?</u>	If you don’t drop the courses you are not attending, you will receive an “F” or a “No evaluation” on your permanent transcript that <u>cannot</u> be removed.

### POINTS TO PONDER FOR OCTOBER
